schools of hope

Do these exist? Where are they? What are they doing that we are not doing?

the culture of poverty

How are the norms of children in poverty different? How can we teach them to succeed in school?

the critical components of a school of hope

A School of Hope develops a particular kind of culture that supports students and encourages collaboration. There are clear norms for effective instruction that all teachers implement. Literacy is infused consistently in all content areas. There is a strong leader who shares responsibility for the school's success.

school culture, relationships

The culture of a building impacts the achievement of students. What are the components of an effective school culture and what leadership actions are productive in growing an effective culture?

instruction for excellence

What are the critical factors that result in an effective classroom? How can we insure that all students learn? Why do some classrooms produce two years of learning (or more) in a single year?

literacy for excellence

Literacy is not just for ELA. Literacy strategies can and should be applied across the curriculum. Literacy strategies have been shown to make a critical difference in student success.

leadership for excellence

The research is clear: leaders make a difference in the success of a school. What can you do to help create a building where students' lives are truly changed?

projects of hope
