

### ***Ohio ranked 24th***

Education Week recently released *Quality Counts 2019*, ranking Ohio 24<sup>th</sup> and assigning it a grade of B- -- slightly above the national average of C+ -- in preparing students for success.

Ohio's ranking improved over recent annual rankings of 26<sup>th</sup> in 2018, 29<sup>th</sup> in 2017 and 27<sup>th</sup> in 2016.

Scores are based on 13 social and education indicators including student test scores, graduation rates, post-secondary education attainment and employment, as well as family income.

The 2019 report will be released in three installments, with school finance in June and K-12 student achievement in September.
