

## ***State Board of Education: New officers, members***

At its January meeting, the State Board of Education elected new officers: at-large member Laura Kohler, who replaces outgoing president Tess Elshoff, and District 3 member Charlotte McGuire, who replaces outgoing vice president Nancy Hollister.

Prior to leaving office, Gov. John Kasich appointed four individuals to fill vacant seats on the State Board: David A. Brinegar, president of Fulton Industries in Wauseon; Cindy A. Collins, a real estate agent from Amanda; Mark A. Lamoncha, president/CEO of Humtown Products in Columbiana; and, Michael A. Toal, president of Everyday Technologies in Sidney.



The State Board is comprised of 19 members – 11 who are elected and eight who are appointed by the governor. The chairs of the education committees of the Ohio House of Representatives and Ohio Senate serve as non-voting ex officio members.
