

Cleveland selected as “Say Yes to Education” City

Cleveland was recently named a “Say Yes to Education” City, providing eligible students – beginning with the high school graduating class of 2019 – who live in Cleveland and graduate from the Cleveland Metropolitan School District (CMSD) or an eligible partnering charter high school, with scholarships up to the value of tuition to all public universities, community colleges and Pell-eligible certificate programs in Ohio, as well as to over 100 private colleges and universities.



At CMSD’s request, the Cleveland Transformation Alliance has recommended new criteria for determining which charter schools are invited to establish formal partnership with the district. Included among the recommendations is a requirement that charter schools seeking to participate in the “Say Yes” initiative be CMSD partners.
